
will follow the presentation.

"East of the Sun"


Multi-award-winning Williams Township author and historian Rebecca Price Janney presents on Korean War MASH units. A book signing will follow Rebecca's presentation.

"What Women Wore 1760-1780"


Living historian Robin Marchionni explores women's clothing and fashion in the colonial period.
